Brief objective of the Call

Enhance efficient public administration by promoting legal and administrative cooperation and cooperation between citizens, civil society actors and institutions, in particular, with a view to resolving legal and other obstacles in border regions through:

- know-how and data exchange to improve strategy development in the cross border region;
- joint pilot actions addressing the removal of border obstacles;
- strengthening the institutional capacity of public authorities/organisations.

Eligible applicants are legal persons of any legal form, with the exception of political parties and political movements.
